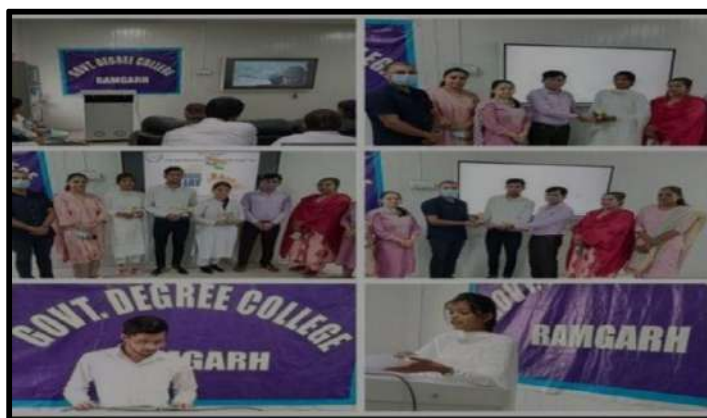

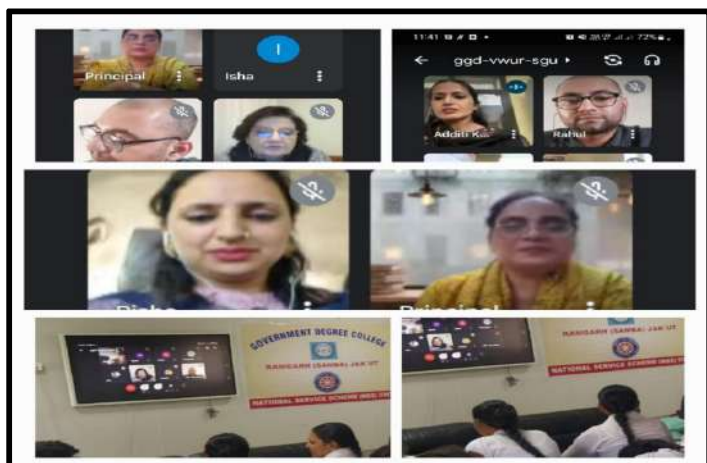

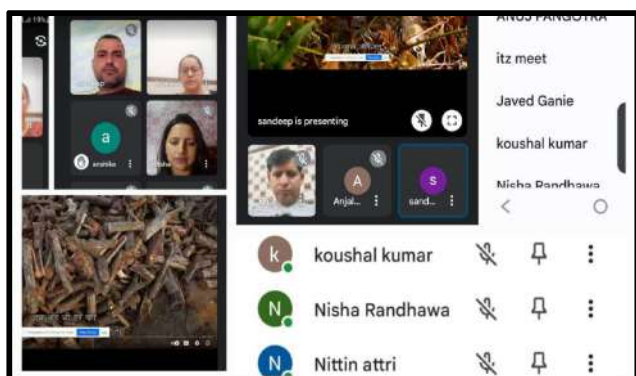

## College Rules and Regulations

5. The use of cell phones is strictly prohibited in and around classrooms except for educational purposes.
6. Coming to the college in an intoxicated state, smoking/drinking/use of drugs within the college premises is strictly prohibited and can invite strict disciplinary action.
7. Using obscene and vulgar words, indulging in malpractice during examinations and moral delinquency are serious offences and are not permitted in the college.
8. Maintaining harmony and mutual respect in the campus is expected from every student.
9. Willful damage to college property cannot be tolerated. Students are expected to keep the college building and premises neat and clean.
10. Whenever students are free, they are expected to go the library.
11. Those who bring vehicles to the college are advised not to indulge in rash driving and wearing helmet is compulsory while riding two-wheelers. Students shall park their vehicles in proper way in the parking area.
12. Relatives or strangers are not allowed to visit students during college hours without prior permission from the Head of the Institution.
13. Students are expected to read all the circulars put up on the notice board as well as college website and act accordingly.
14. The college gate will be closed from 10:00 AM to 1:40 PM. During this period, students are not permitted to leave the campus except with the permission of the Head of the Institution.
15. All the students are bound to follow Eco friendliness and Eco-consciousness in the campus.
16. A grievance redressal cell exists in the institution. Students are advised to approach the faculty-in charge of grievance redressal cell for getting their grievance addressed.
17. Any form of ragging, including verbal abuse, teasing, derogatory comments, mistreatment of vulnerable students, or harassment of women, will be strictly addressed and penalized on campus.
18. To address the issue of ragging, an anti-ragging cell has been established. This team will be vigilant throughout the campus, and anyone found engaging in ragging activities will face strict penalties, including potential expulsion from the college.
