Government Degree College Ramgarh, Samba (J&K), a co-educational institution, affiliated to University of Jammu was established in 2019 by Higher Education Department Government of Jammu and Kashmir under the patronage of Jenab Talat Parvez Rohella Commissioner Secretary, Higher Education Department. The college is about 8 Kms. away towards west from the National Highway (NH A1). At present it is housed in the premises of Government Middle School Kalan, opposite Bawa Sidh Goria Temple, Swankha.

The college aims to enrich a vibrant value based learning environment so as to transform it into a centre of excellence. It imparts knowledge in all spheres of life so that students may think beyond unthinkable and see beyond unseen.






with J & K AIDS Control Society, Health and Medical Department, J&K.


